Airway Management/Preadmission Testing/ Dual Antiplatelet Therapy - Jon D. Samuels, MD, BobbieJean Sweitzer, MD and David L. Hepner, MD

Minimize risk for aspiration in obese patients undergoing surgery; Identify risk factors for difficult airway in patients with obesity; Recognize perioperative risks associated with heart failure; Select appropriate preoperative cardiac tests; Apply current guidelines for dual antiplatelet therapy when evaluating patients with coronary stents in preparation for noncardiac surgery

Anesthesia for Liver Transplantation - Niraj Agarwalla, DO,

Select appropriate candidates for liver transplantation; Preoperatively evaluate the cardiac status of candidates for liver transplantation; Assess pulmonary vascular indices in candidates for liver transplantation; Choose invasive and noninvasive intraoperative cardiovascular monitors for patients to undergo liver transplantation; Optimize intraoperative coagulation status during liver transplantation.

Elaborate on factors contributing to maternal morbidity and mortality after cesarean delivery; Cite current guidelines addressing enhanced recovery after cesarean delivery (ERAC); Incorporate multimodal analgesia into institutional protocols for cesarean delivery; Ensure adequate monitoring for women who receive neuraxial opioids; Successfully implement ERAC programs.

Recognize the prevalence of common congenital cardiac anomalies; Differentiate among different types of congenital heart disease; Explain the hemodynamic abnormalities associated with repaired and unrepaired congenital heart defects; Appreciate the effects of congenital heart disease on multiple organ systems; Implement anesthetic strategies to optimize cardiovascular function during noncardiac surgery for patients with congenital cardiac anomalies.

Weigh the advantages and disadvantages of preoperative cardiac testing; Factor the degree of discordance among preoperative cardiac assessment tools into decision making; Identify patients with good indications for preoperative cardiac testing; Recognize the challenges associated with developing a machine-learning model to predict respiratory decompensation; Elaborate on the steps involved in the creation of a machinelearning algorithm for predicting and treating hypotension during cesarean delivery.

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Preoperative Issues in Anesthesia - Jeanna D. Blitz, MD and M. Concetta Lupa, MD

Elaborate on current terminology used to describe sex and gender; Explain the benefits, risks, and perioperative implications of hormonal therapy for transgendered individuals; Recognize the effects of preoperative anxiety in children on postoperative recovery; Administer appropriate pharmacologic anxiolytic premedication to children undergoing surgery; Identify children likely to benefit from nonpharmacologic methods for reducing anxiety preoperatively and during induction of anesthesia.

Estimate the severity of burn injuries; Recognize the indications for referring patients with burns to higher levels of care; Elaborate on the physiologic derangements associated with burn injuries; Monitor patients with burns intraoperatively; Design effective pain control regimens for patients with burns.

Recognize patients' perceptions of physicians and health care systems; Implement perioperative care pathways to maintain patient brain health; Avoid medication errors and other preventable harm during the perioperative period; Advocate for systemic changes to health care systems to optimize physician well-being and avoid burnout; Proactively address waste in health care systems.
